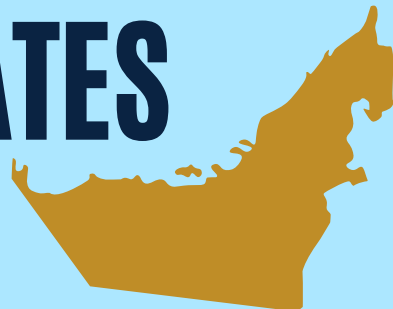

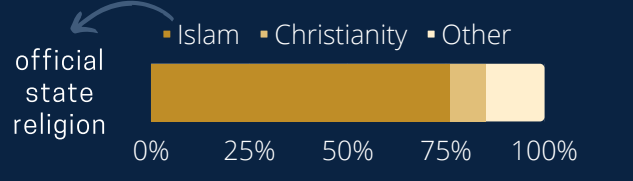

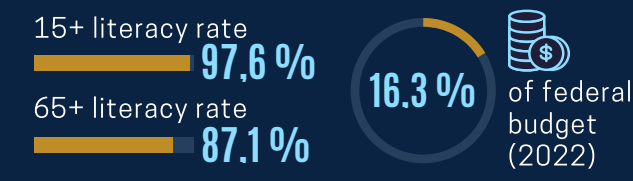

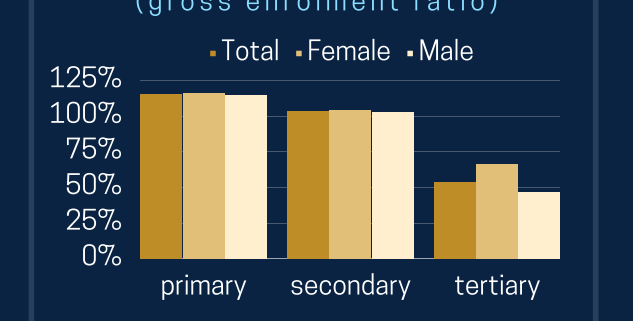

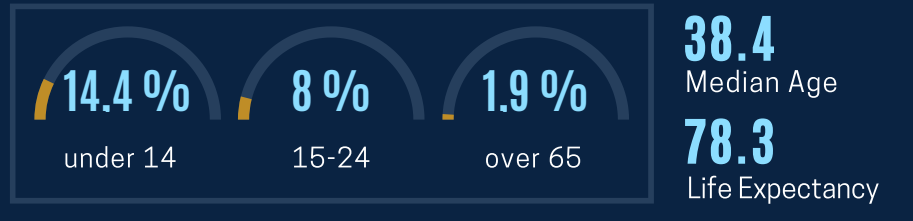
PARTICIPATION IN EDUCATION

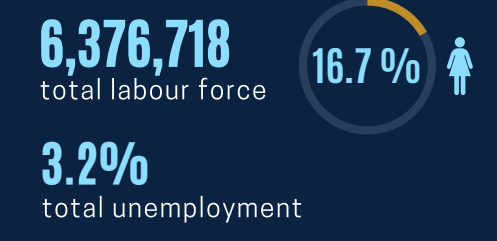

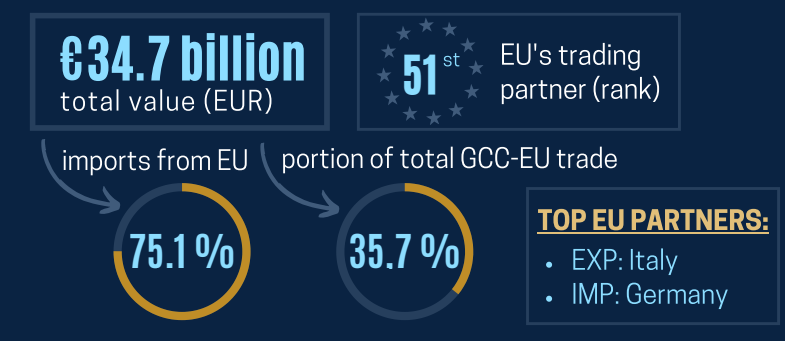

KEY DATES

2 December 1971: National Day
Independence from the United Kingdom, formation of the United Arab Emirates

10 February 1972
The seventh emirate, Ras Al Khaimah, joined the federation

May 1996
Permanent Constitution adopted

Supreme Council

7 members (rulers of the individual emirates)

- the highest authority
- elects President, Vice-President and Council of Ministers

LEGISLATIVE unicameral Federal National Council

40 members

- 20 indirectly elected
- 20 appointed by rulers of each emirate
